A RESOLUTION APPOINTING CONFLICT PROSECUTOR

WHEREAS, there exists a need for Conflict Prosecutor to handle any Conflict Issues that may arise for the Township of Lumberton; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts law (NJSA 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that the resolution authorizing award of contracts for “Professional Services” to Paul Dougherty, Esq., of Haddon Heights, NJ without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington and State of New Jersey, that;

SECTION I

The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Paul Dougherty, Esq., of 115 North Black Horse Pike, Haddon Heights, NJ 08035 as Conflict Prosecutor for any Lumberton Township conflict issues.

SECTION II

This contract was awarded without competitive bid as a “Professional Service” under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because they are recognized professions under the laws of the State of New Jersey, and, therefore, not possible to obtain competitive bids pursuant to NJSA 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) the following information is set forth:


- A. Nature of Contract: Conflict Prosecutor
