ORDINANCE 2016-15**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE 2015-03-004 OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON, COUNTY OF
BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY**

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, New Jersey ("Township") has heretofore duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinance 2015-03-004 authorizing the acquisition of various pieces of equipment and the completion of various capital improvements in and for the Township ("Bond Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of amending Section 3(a) of the Bond Ordinance to revise the purposes set forth therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ALL THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL BOND LAW, CHAPTER 169 OF THE LAWS OF 1960 OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED ("LOCAL BOND LAW"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3(a) of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

II.	Reconstruction of Township roads, including but not limited to All Spice, phase II and Maple Grove Boulevard, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	216,296	10,814.80	205,481.20	20 years

Reconstruction and improvements to Township intersections, including but not limited to Rothybury and Windermere, Tynemouth and Windermere North and Tynemouth and Windermere South, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	120,400	6,020	114,380	10 years
IV.	Capital maintenance to grounds and equipment at Township playground and athletic fields, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	99,761	4,988.05	94,772.95	15 years
V.	Drainage improvements to Township athletic fields, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	49,815	2,490.75	47,324.25	15 years
VI.	Acquisition of office furniture and equipment at municipal offices, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	24,287	1,214.35	23,072.65	5 years
VII.	Upgrades to HVAC systems at municipal buildings, and including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	199,801	9,990.05	189,810.95	10 years
VIII.	Acquisition of vehicle (SUV or Pick-Up) for Township Construction Department, including all work and related materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	24,708	1,235.40	23,472.60	5 years

Section 2. Section 6(b) of the Bond Ordinance is hereby amended to provide as follows:

“The average period of usefulness of the improvements or purposes, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, computed on the basis of respective amounts or obligations for the several purposes and the respective reasonable life thereof within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, is 14.47 years.”

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the regulations promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail the amended capital budget and capital improvement program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, are on file with the Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 4. All other parts of the Bond Ordinance not amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. In accordance with the Local Bond Law, this ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage




