WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has conducted interviews and recommends the hiring of Timothy Pearson, and;


WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that there are now sufficient funds in the Township budget to hire an additional police officer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey hereby approves of the hiring of Timothy Pearson as a full time Police Officer for the Lumberton Township Police Department effective March 5th, 2016 and at the salary of \$38,000.00 in accordance with terms of the CBA by and between the Township and the Lumberton Township Police Officers Association; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Timothy Pearson shall not be entitled to any accrued personal, sick or vacation time upon his hiring.
