

TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-09-008

**ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$ 23,077.59
PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR
THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO
PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN UNMARKED
POLICE UTILITY VEHICLE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF
LUMBERTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON,
NEW JERSEY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that \$23,077.59 of the proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the following bond ordinances of the Township of Lumberton, in the County of Burlington, New Jersey are no longer necessary for the purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized:

Section 3. The \$23,077.59 proceeds described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 are hereby reappropriated to provide for the Acquisition of one Police SUV, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.


Section 4. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of

any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
