ORDINANCE 2015 – 02-002

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON
MANDATING DIRECT DEPOSIT OF PAYROLL**

WHEREAS, Public Law 2013, c. 28 authorizes municipalities to mandate direct deposit for its employees and elected officials after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Township believes that such a process will increase the efficiency of payroll operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f, employees and elected officials of the Township of Lumberton shall be required to receive their pay through direct deposit at a bank institution of their choice;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Chief Financial Officer shall establish the system within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the adoption of this Ordinance;

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED, that municipal employees may request, in writing, an exemption from the direct deposit mandate to the Chief Financial Officer. Such requests will be presented to the Township Committee at their next regularly scheduled meeting. The Committee may grant such an exemption by resolution and only for good cause.

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Committee hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.
- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
